Any school age, but under 19 Years

Class 1	Junior Intro individual dressage Test - Intro C (2016) Up to 35 prelim points, 0 points at novice or above. Horses cannot have competed in Novice or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.
Class 2	Junior Dressage Team a) Prelim 7[2002] b) Prelim 13 [2006] c) Prelim 18 [2002] d) Novice 24 [2010]
Class 2a	Prelim 7 [2002] Horses may have Unlimited Prelim Points Up to 35 points at Novice, 0 points at Elementary or above. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC
Class 2b	Prelim 13 [2006] Horses may have Unlimited Prelim Points Up to 35 points at Novice, 0 points at Elementary or above. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.
Class 2c	Prelim 18 [2002] Horses may have Unlimited Prelim Points Up to 35 points at Novice, 0 points at Elementary or above. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC
Class 2d	Novice 24 [2010] Horses can have unlimited Novice points and up to 35 Elementary pts, 0 points at Medium or above
Class 4	Junior Elementary Dressage Elementary 43 [2006] 20 x 60 arena Horses can have unlimited BD Elementary points and up to 35 Medium points No Adv medium points or above

Class 2: Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. One rider to compete in each class

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings.
